DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Agility trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows may participate provided they are AKC registered. Mixed breeds, dogs not registerable with the AKC, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate.

Opening day January 6, 2010 at 6 AM.

Closing day is March 3, 2010 at 6 PM

Entries will NOT be accepted unless left WITHOUT signature required. Entries received before the opening time and date MUST be returned to sender.

Per New AKC rules: Only 10 ENTRIES maximum per envelope.

No hand delivered will be accepted for the first 24 hours the trial is open. Entries received opening day must include postage or be metered or be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, DHL. Any entries not meeting the above requirements must be returned.

For fast acknowledgment of entry, enclose a SASE or e-mail address.

FAX ENTRIES OR FAXED MOVE-UPS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

All entries will be acknowledged after entries close with a judging program.

Should acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height of each class and division provided they have earned a qualifying score. Each qualifying run will earn a dark green ribbon. A MACH & PAX bar and rosette will be offered to any team completing their title at these trials. A new title rosette will be offered to any exhibitor completing a title at these trials. No unclaimed awards or ribbons will be mailed.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

From the SOUTH: US23 North to I94 West to Baker Rd – exit 167. Go 2.7 miles to Main St. Left on Main. First street on the right is Central. .6miles to Joy Rd (just after party store) turn right on Joy.

.3 miles on right is CSRC

From the EAST: I94 West to Baker Street Exit 167 or M14 to I94 to Baker Exit. Follow the directions above.

From the NORTH: US23 South to North Territorial Exit 49 Turn right, go 6 miles to Mast Rd (4way stop)

Left on Mast Rd Go 3 miles to Joy Rd – turn left. .3miles on right - CSRC

MEASURING

In accordance with AKC regulations, all dogs must either present a temporary or permanent jump height card, or be measured prior to the running of that dog. We will accept copies of your jump height cards attached to the back of your entry form, in its actual size – please! All exhibitors and/or handlers are responsible for entering their dog in the proper height division. The judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in the trial that have not been issued a permanent measurement card. A VMO may or may not be present at this trial.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without dogs, prior to the start of each class before or after the Judge's briefing. This walk through allows handlers to plan their strategy for the running of the course. There will not be an equipment familiarization for Novice. No excessive training or corrections on the grounds will be allowed. A WARM UP jump area consisting of one regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors. This is not to be used as for training.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Telephone or telegraphed entries, conditioned entries, and/or photocopied entries without the AKC agreement on the back are not acceptable. Incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable and cannot be entered in the show. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Section 4)
- No entry shall be made and no entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- \$10 per entry for bitches in season, whose owner supplies the club with a letter from their vet stating she is in estrus before March 19, 2010 8am.
- No other refunds after closing for any reason.
- Make checks and money orders payable to Oakland County KC (OCKC) in U.S. funds. OCKC is not responsible for cash sent in mail. Post-dated or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service fee for returned checks and all future entries made by the person on that checking account will be put on a CASH ONLY or MONEY ORDER only basis.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with a mailed confirmation and judging program. Oakland County Kennel club may decline any entries and may remove any dog because of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against OCKC, or any official thereof or any persons assisting with this show.
- Errors on entry forms: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whatsoever may make such errors, and no entry shall be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of such entries after the closing date.
- Please type or print carefully the information on the entry form to eliminate errors.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, in season, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Agility Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance, or other act beyond the control of the Agility Show Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. OCKC will not be responsible, nor is it obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Conflicts will be handled on an individual basis. The judge will not hold up any class judging or wait for any dog that is in conflict with their agility ring time!
- All dogs must be held on leash or confined except when being judged and when in the warm up or exercise area. The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this show, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dog is familiar with & able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under the age of 6 months are strictly prohibited from the show site.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials.
- NO alcoholic beverages on premises.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Michigan requires an official interstate health certificate or official certificate of veterinary inspection. Also a Rabies vaccination by a licensed veterinarian within one year/three years (according to vaccine label directions). Certificate is valid for 30 days from date of examination. Airline certificates are valid for 30 days from date of examination.

MOVE UP POLICY

Deadline for move ups will be at 6 P.M. March 15, 2010 for Fridays trial. No email move ups will be accepted after this date. Day to Day move ups may be made from Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday as long as the request is received by the Trial Secretary ONLY, at least 30 minutes after the end of Friday and/or Saturday's trial. AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes and the FAST titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
